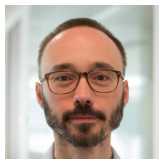

THE GREAT LIBRARY OF SOURCE CODE

Collect, preserve forever, and make publicly available the entire body of software, in the preferred form for making modifications to it.

- Started by UNESCO and Inria in 2015
- Archive of source code & VCS history
- Coverage: 200 M projects — major forges (GitHub, GitLab.com, ...), Linux distros, package manager repositories
- Use cases: **cultural** preservation, large-scale software **research**, source code tracking for the IT **industry**

General: how Software Heritage can help [your] FOSS sustainability research.

Research topics

- FOSS **sustainability beyond for-profit** business models — e.g., the role of non-profits, researchers, civil servants, public bodies in general.
- FOSS **phylogenetics**: identify project “rebirths” (as a whole or of their sub-parts) in unexpected places (e.g., exogenous forks across forges).
- **Human aspects**: empirical investigations of the impact of diversity on project “health” (FSVO).
